A Waldorf certificate or degree is preferred but not necessary (willingness to participate in Waldorf training a plus).

Waldorf faculty members are an integral part of the governance of the school. The teacher will work collaboratively within the Grades department. We seek candidates who are committed to the values of Waldorf education, a teacher who is joyful and warm, with strong interpersonal communication skills, effective classroom management, and enthusiasm for teaching and learning.
