The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications:

- Fluid knowledge of the Spanish language and culture
- Successful experience in Waldorf teaching is preferred; experience in any form of teaching will be considered
- Strong classroom management
- Ability to collaborate with the faculty on curriculum
- Ability to communicate effectively and respectfully with students and parents
- Waldorf training preferred; Bachelor's degree is required

The right candidate will:

- Teach three 40-minute periods per week for each grade, grades one through eight
- Create lessons that include songs, games, poetry, cultural experiences, and conversational instruction, appropriate to the grade level
- Attend a weekly mentor meeting with the other specialty faculty, usually held during a lunch period
- Communicate concerns to parents/guardians
- Write end of the year reports
- Participate in the Thursday afternoon faculty meetings
