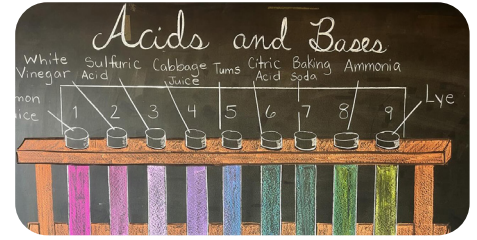


# Spanish Teacher for 2025/2026 School Year

The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications:

- Solid knowledge of Spanish language and culture
- Strong classroom management
- Ability to collaborate with the faculty on curriculum
- Ability to communicate effectively with students and parents
- Bachelor's degree
- Prior teaching experience

The right candidate will:

- Teach two to three 50-minute periods for each grade, one through eight
- Attend a weekly mentor meeting with the other specialty faculty, usually held during a lunch period
- Communicate directly with faculty and parents/guardians
- Write end-of-the-year reports

The ability to be flexible, bring joy and laughter and the love of learning is a big plus. The hourly rate range for this position is \$20.49-\$24.49 and is based on experience.
