The assistant will work collaboratively within the Early Childhood department and the Lead class teacher. We seek a candidate who is committed to the values of Waldorf education, who is joyful and warm, with strong interpersonal communication skills, effective classroom management, and enthusiasm for teaching and learning.

#### **Duties will include:**

- -Assist with the smooth running of the program.
- -Carry logistical aspects of the morning, i.e. mixing paints, kneading dough, washing dishes, dressing the children for outdoors, helping with the bathroom.
- -Help with puppet plays, in daily set-up and clean-up, with craft projects and on the playground.
- -Substitute for the teacher when needed.

- -Participate in child observation and study when possible.
